


Wine delivered to your door...



Sad though we are to see our beloved shop closed temporarily, we are really excited to say that we will be able to deliver wine to your doorstep, wines that you are familiar with from our shop and cellars. In order to do this we will be working in conjunction with one of our suppliers, and their delivery team.

This is how it will work:

1. First check your delivery area from the list on the page below.
2. Choose your wines and/or beers and gin from either this special offers list or the full list which you have also been sent. (Wines will only be available as unmixed cases of 6 bottles, we can't currently supply mixed cases.)
3. Please note that in Zones 1 to 5, to be able to use our suppliers delivery team we have to ask you to purchase at least a minimum of 3 unmixed cases. Apologies, in Zone 6 you will need to purchase at least 5 unmixed cases. With many of the cases the saving you make on the offers will cover the delivery charges.
4. Cases of beer (of 12 bottles) can be added to your order, as can single bottles of gin.
5. Email us on **dbyrneandco@gmail.com** with your order and we will contact you for payment. Delivery will be made within 3-5 working days.
6. Enquires and orders may only be taken by email, our phones are not currently manned since our staff are currently working from home.

**False Bay 'Whole Bunch'
Cinsault Mourvèdre Rosé**
SOUTH AFRICA

A pale, spicy and textural Rosé mostly sourced from bush-vine Cinsault with summer fruits on the palate and a lovely clean, savoury, dry finish.

**False Bay 'Windswept'
Sauvignon Blanc**
SOUTH AFRICA

Fabulous seaside Sauvignon. Fresh and zesty with grassy and dry bay leaf aromatics, fynbos (indigenous South African bush), mineral notes, with hints of richness. This is a restrained Sauvignon Blanc with a palate that has lots of minerality and citrus with just a touch of green pepper and grass.



**False Bay 'Slow'
Chenin Blanc**
SOUTH AFRICA

The long wild yeast ferment provides bready aromas and additional complexity to the wine. Dried herbaceous notes, including fennel and aniseed from the nearby fynbos, dominate the nose, followed by a creamy lemon character. The palate is reminiscent of the nose, with great textural complexity, attributable to the long, slow wild yeast fermentation.



We also have a fabulous Shiraz in the Seriti range available.

Seriti Merlot
SOUTH AFRICA

Attractively soft, creamy, chocolatey nose and a palate bathed in dusky spice. Lush, ripe and deep in hue, this is a plump and sensuous Merlot with flavours of hedgerow fruits and a fine, gently leafy finish.



Sunshine Wines

We may be in lockdown but at least we have the sunshine for the time being. What perfect wines to drink!

Check out the Beatnik Rosé from the USA, our very own Kate Byrne designed the label – a true party wine, gather whoever you have with you, put some music on and dance (the cat/dog might appreciate the spectacle.)

The other two French rosés are perfectly designed for drinking either with food or whilst lounging in a deck chair with a favourite book.

**La Ruchette Dorée,
Côtes du Rhône Rosé
FRANCE**

A vibrant, luscious, fruity and full flavoured rosé with redcurrant and wildflower and strawberry fruit characters. Although the Rhône is known primarily for red wine, the rosés, especially those from garrigue-strewn vineyards such as these, are a southern French treat.

Light pink in colour, with an incredibly expressive nose. This wine offers a delicate, balanced and refreshing mouthful. Also available as a magnum.

The term 'Beatnik' was first used in the San Francisco Chronicle in 1958 so it's apt that this wine is made from 100% Zinfandel grapes sourced from growers in Lodi. Drink this Californian rosé and taste the light and lush strawberry flavours that finish with a ripe, medium finish.

A little gem from Saint Georges d'Orques in the south of France. Delicate, sweet spice aromas lead onto a palate which is immediately soft, vinous and round with abundant ripe fruit, lifted by a natural zing and finishing with a characterful texture and richness.

**Percheron Chenin Blanc
Viognier**
SOUTH AFRICA

Vibrant and aromatic with delicious subtle perfumed aromas with white peach and hints of jasmine on the nose. On the palate it has tight, white, fleshy stone fruit and fresh apricot flavours that balances the sandy texture. Bright acidity and minerality helps to deliver a delicious flavoursome and characteristic wine.

**Il Cascinone 'Camillona'
Sauvignon Blanc**
ITALY

A fine, elegant style of Sauvignon with citrus fruit characters lifted by ripe gooseberry and floral notes. Zesty acidity balances perfectly with the considerable weight on the palate, and crisp grapefruit flavours make this an attractive and characterful wine.

Quite simply the best Pinot Noir you will find at this price! A delicate and elegant Pinot Noir showing ripe fruit flavours of plums and wild strawberries, balanced with subtle smoky notes and a deliciously lingering finish.

Barbera d'Asti**

This wine was created by Andrew and his wife Isabel when on holiday in Italy last year. Deep purple in colour with intense Damson fruit characters. It is ripe and generous on the palate, robust and full-flavoured, all balanced by a tangy, juicy acidity.

“ One of our favourite Southern French reds appeared back in the UK at the end of last year, because the estate produces so little, the wines of Prieuré Saint Jean de Bebian hadn't been imported for the best part of a decade. Not only have we secured a small parcel of their two top reds but we've also got some superb prices for you. ”



The Languedoc is often thought of as France's engine room, it is after all the second largest wine region in the world just behind Castilla La-Mancha. But if the Languedoc is the engine room, Prieuré Saint Jean de Bebian is a Rolls Royce. It has quite a pedigree.

We're down in the rolling hills near Pézenas here, in vineyards first planted by Cistercian monks who also built the Priory church of Saint Jean in 1152. Just over 30 hectares is broken into 45 different blocks and 3 different major soil types; galets, basalt and limestone... Burgundy eat your heart out!

Of course, it's warm in the South of France, on paper these look like big wines, but in reality they have a finesse and purity that feels balanced and fresh. The varieties are the classic Southern French ones you'd expect. Grenache is a real star of the reds; it produces wine with stunning concentration from the galets rous soil which is almost identical to that found in Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

There's a fine 'Heritage' here with proven, consistent, seriously high-quality winemaking over many years and the estate is consistently amongst the most highly regarded in the whole of the Languedoc.

You're going to absolutely love these wines!



Chapelle de Bebian Rouge, Coteaux de Languedoc [Organic] 2016

Around 80 % Syrah and 20 % Mourvedre, this is a powerful and spicy wine. 2016 was a warm vintage which translates to a powerful wine, but the heat of alcohol is not felt at all given the purity and concentration of dark fruit.

Prieure Saint Jean de Bebian Rouge, Coteaux de Languedoc [Organic] 2016

Grenache dominant blend with Cinsault and Syrah. You wouldn't expect to use words like "purity" and "freshness" perhaps in this part of the world, but this is a special place. Concentrated, juicy, with a touch of garrigue herbs and a very long finish.



Fontanino Riesling
PIEMONTE, ITALY

A dry, minerally and textured Riesling that shows the potential for the variety in Piemonte. This is a fine, delicate dry white with classic Riesling aromas of lime, petrol and a touch of lemongrass. The palate has citrus and stone fruit characters, with mineral notes adding complexity to the finish.

Leccio Monferrato Chiaretto
PIEMONTE, ITALY

This delicious Chiaretto is sure to give any hardened Francophile a compelling alternative. Made primarily from Pinot Noir, this is fresh with plenty of crunchy red summer fruit character. Pretty pale pink in colour. The nose is lifted with cherry, raspberry and gently floral notes. The palate balances tangy cherry and red berry fruit with crisp, incisive acidity.

Campo Fiorito Chardonnay
PIEMONTE, ITALY

A delicate nose of ripe stone fruit and a hint of creamy oak. The complex palate is well-balanced with ripe peach characters, a broad mouthfeel and some toasty oak in the background.

Soliti Merlot
PIEMONTE, ITALY

A structured, plummy Merlot from a 2.5 hectare plot on the Il Cascinone estate that punches well above its weight. Plum, blackberry and savoury spice characters on the nose. Full flavoured with layers of black fruit and toasty spice backed by firm, ripe tannins, dark chocolate notes and a fresh finish.

2018 Chateau Tirecul 'Ulma' Blanc
BERGERAC, FRANCE

£55.14 *per case of 6 bottles

A fresh blend of Semillon, Muscadelle, Chenin and Sauvignon blanc. Notes of rich stone fruit and a great texture from lees ageing. This is a summery, smiling, singing glass of wine.

**2018 Domaine du Monteillet,
Les Hauts du Monteillet Blanc**
NORTHERN RHONE, FRANCE

£76.74 *per case of 6 bottles

A fabulously fresh white. The majority is Viognier, with the balance made up of Clairette Blanc and a touch of Rousanne. At 12.5% this is delightfully drinkable. Peach, orange blossom and vanilla on the nose with a charming bright fruit palate. Interestingly there is a salty, tangy finish which provides real interest.



Melon Blanc Vendange Nocturne
LOIRE, FRANCE

Already quite modern in style, this vintage has allowed the fruit character to really shine whilst remaining deliciously fresh and bright, with a more typical touch of salinity and spritz on the finish.



**Boutinot 'La Fleur Solitaire',
Côtes du Rhône Blanc**
RHÔNE, FRANCE

£46.74 *per case of 6 bottles

Proper white Côtes du Rhône; fresh, medium-bodied, vinous. The nose is pretty and delicate, with a waft of fennel tops and hints of hedgerow flowers. The flavours are nuanced and refined rather than overt. Careful use of oak adds texture and structure without masking the freshness of this very drinkable white.



**Boutinot 'Les Cerisiers',
Côtes du Rhône Rosé**
RHÔNE, FRANCE

A classic salmon pink rosé with delicate perfumed aromas of rosehip syrup, wild berry blossoms and cherries on the nose. Full flavoured, ripe and beautifully balanced with acidity, there's elegant, textured, berry fruit on the palate with a twist of raspberry freshness to lift the finish.



**2018 Domaine de la Grande
Courtade Chardonnay**
LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

No pomp and ceremony here, just incredibly drinkable Chardonnay. Some vines with decent age and concentration, a skilled hand to introduce just the right amount of oak and battonage and some bright acidity to keep you coming back for more. Sometimes less really is more.



**Cave de Turckheim Riesling
'Marnes et Calcaires'**
ALSACE, FRANCE

£56.34 *per case of 6 bottles

An exemplary, delicate Alsatian Riesling. Bottle age has lent an alluringly complex baked citrus nose. Racy, dry and elegant, this is a fine Riesling with potential to age.



Château L'Ermitage Rosé 'Auzan'
RHÔNE, FRANCE

This is a delicious, modern southern French rosé packed full of flavour. There's a pretty, aromatic nose with a cranberry flavours on the palate with just a hint of tannin underpinning the bright acidity. Elegant and well balanced this is a great food rosé.



Petit Chablis Bernard Michaut
BURGUNDY, FRANCE

A second label from Domaine de la Motte but the same deliciously approachable Chardonnay fruit with the proper 'tension' and backbone you expect from good Chablis.

**2018 Clos Bagatelle 'À L'Origine',
Saint-Chinian Rouge**
LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

£49.74 *per case of 6 bottles

In the glass, the wine has a bright ruby colour with a fresh, herby, garrigue nose. A touch of liquorice is followed by full-flavoured and intense, typically southern flavours. Equal measures of Syrah, Carignan and Grenache and a dash of Mouvèdre provide youth, excellent balance and generous and gentle structure.



Spain:



Cabriola by Borsao CAMPO DE BORJA, SPAIN £73.74 *per case of 6 bottles

A rich and characterful Grenache Syrah blend from Borsao's high altitude, low-yielding vineyards. Pronounced ripe red fruit aromas with a touch of vanilla and a lightly herbal note. The palate is full and well-structured with bramble and berry fruit alongside toasty notes and sweet spice. Ripe, supple tannins and juicy acidity give a long and balanced finish.

Borsao Selección Rosado CAMPO DE BORJA, SPAIN £37.14 *per case of 6 bottles

A delightfully pale Garnacha rosé with intense aromas of bright red fruits, raspberries and strawberries. The palate has ripe red berry and cherry fruit characters, balancing acidity, and an appealing red fruit finish.



One of Borsao's top wines and new to the D. Byrne cellars. It's a fantastically tasty wine and to top it all, it's made in collaboration with one of THE best winemakers – Chris Ringland. Chris is rightly renowned for his own wines, Rockford Basket Press Shiraz and Three Rivers Barossa Shiraz (currently retailing for over £1000 per bottle and rare as hens' teeth).

La Báscula 'Atlantic Way' Albariño RIAS BAIXAS, SPAIN £55.74 *per case of 6 bottles

Fresh citrus aromas with some lightly nutty and white spice characters. The palate has appealing ripe stone fruit, with lime and mineral notes, balanced by zesty acidity.



Señorio de Sarría Chardonnay NAVARRA, SPAIN £41.94 *per case of 6 bottles

An unoaked Chardonnay with intense, lively citrus fruit and apple skin aromas. Quite full on the palate with ripe peach and apricot characters balanced by crisp acidity.

Ontañón Tempranillo Blanco RIOJA, SPAIN £50.94 *per case of 6 bottles

Intense tropical fruit aromas with hints of pineapple, white flower and citrus. The palate has texture, minerality and balance with ripe stone fruit characters, a hint of orange blossom, crisp acidity and a lengthy finish.



Ontañón Rioja Gran Reserva RIOJA, SPAIN £117.54 *per case of 6 bottles

Beautifully developed Rioja with aromas of dark fruit, red cherry, spice, tobacco and mocha. The palate shows complexity and structure with layers of black fruit, spice and toasty oak to give a long and elegant finish.

Prisma Organic Monastrell [Organic]
JUMILLA, SPAIN

£41.94 *per case of 6 bottles

A ripe, opulent, classic southern Spanish Monastrell from organic vineyards. Complex nose of ripe plums and rich red fruit, with notes of fig. On the palate the wine is generous, rich and spicy - with concentrated red and black fruit, supple tannins, and fresh acidity on the finish.



Señorio de Sarria Crianza
NAVARRA, SPAIN

Vibrant berry fruits offset spicy red cherry, balsamic, lightly herbal and cedar notes from 12 months in oak. Typically spicy black fruit palate with some structure and weight.



2017/18 Mineral del Montsant
MONTSANT DO, SPAIN

£61.14 *per case of 6 bottles

Appealing aromas of raspberry and a touch of slate. The palate has fresh, vibrant berry fruits, minerality and lightly smoky, spicy notes. An intense and broad wine balanced by refreshing acidity.



2012/14 Laderas de Cabama Rioja
RIOJA, SPAIN

£61.14 *per case of 6 bottles

A pure and elegant single vineyard Rioja. Produced from 30 year old, 100% Tempranillo vines. Hand harvested grapes are aged in 80% French and 20% Russian oak for 12 months - so effectively a declassified Reserva. Pure, poised and dark-fruited with balsamic notes, elegance and a lightness of touch.



Germany:

2018/19 Horst Sauer Escherndorfer Müller Thurgau Trocken
FRANKEN, GERMANY

£65.94 *per case of 6 bottles

That's a hell of a mouthful when you try to order this from a restaurant list! But then it's also a hell of a mouthful when it arrives in your glass too. Bright floral and ripe apple aromas, with stone fruit, a gentle touch of spice and lightly honeyed character on the finish. The palate is rounded, textured and very long.



2018 Weingut AJ Adam im Pfarrgarten Riesling Feinherb
MOSEL GERMANY

£65.94 *per case of 6 bottles

Complex aromas of lime, grapefruit and white spice. Abundant citrus characters on the palate combined with crisp, zesty acidity ensures that, despite residual sugar levels of around 18g/l, the wine has a creamy yet refreshing finish.



2017/18 Hexamer Grauburgunder Trocken NAHE, GERMANY

£65.94 *per case of 6 bottles

Another curious oddity here. Pinot Gris has a naturally lower acidity so together with some late picking this is the equivalent of lowering yourself into a nice deep bath. A wine to relax into.



Hungary:

2018 Kardos Dry Furmint
MÁD, TOKAJ, HUNGARY

Pale green in colour with a fresh grapefruit nose. Notes of grapefruit, pear and lime. which follow through on the palate. Dry and beautifully crisp with an elegant minerality which keeps the wine in balance. With a refreshing bitter edge on the finish.



Italy:

Lunetta Prosecco Spumante Brut NV
VENETO, ITALY

A deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach on the nose and a fresh, softly sparkling palate with characters of soft ripe stone fruits.

A fresh and dry sparkling rosé with persistent white foam, beautifully cherry pink in colour. Red berry characters on the nose and palate make this soft and approachable in character. - now in a handy 'single serve' size too!

2018/19 Monte Schiavo Ruviano Verdicchio Classico [Organic]
MARCHE, ITALY
£39.54 *per case of 6 bottles

A clean, modern and approachable style of Verdicchio - it offers exceptional depth and concentration for the price. The nose is fresh with apricot and orchard fruit aromas, and a hint of white flower and citrus. The palate has minerality and texture with ripe stone fruit and grapefruit characters, a refreshing acidity and a crisp finish.



Feudo Maccari Olli Grillo
SICILIA, ITALY
£49.14 *per case of 6 bottles

Fresh and lightly honeyed on the nose with savoury, nutty notes and hints of citrus peel. The palate is complex with crisp citrus flavours, ripe stone fruit, and tropical characters on the textured mid-palate. A subtle and multi-layered wine with immediately appealing freshness and fruit leading to a taut, savoury, mineral finish.



La Battistina Gavi
PIEMONTE, ITALY

Aromatic, zesty nose with notes of apple, lime and white flower. The wine has juicy apple and lemon characters, and is textural with attractive minerality. The finish is balanced, with a zesty mouthwatering quality.



Vidussi Collio Ribolla Gialla
FRIULI, ITALY

Fresh and aromatic with notes of guava, mandarin and hints of white pepper. Vibrant fruit on the palate with passion fruit and ripe citrus held together by the racy acidity and mineral notes typical of the Ribolla grape.





Alasia Moscato d'Asti
PIEMONTE, ITALY

Sweet and gently sparkling with delicate aromas of honey, flowers and fresh grapes. On the palate the wine reveals ripe apricot, grape notes and a soft mousse. Delightful refreshing acidity on the finish to balance the sweetness, and all that at 5% ABV. A wine to make you smile!

Araldica Piemonte Cortese
PIEMONTE, ITALY

A great value, zesty dry white. Fresh, primary fruit aromas of green apples, grapefruit and ripe citrus fruit on the nose with lightly honeyed, lemony notes on the palate. The finish is fresh and crisp with citrus flavours, a hint of almond and mineral touches.



Bottega Vinai Trentino Nosiola
TRENTINO, ITALY

Appealing aromas of apple and pear with lightly floral notes. The palate is fresh yet textural with orchard and stone fruit characters, a touch of honey and white spice, and a lightly nutty finish.



Bottega Vinai Trentino Pinot Grigio
TRENTINO, ITALY

Lightly honeyed spicy nose with distinct floral, apple and citrus notes. Added complexity from white spice, honey and almond characters. On the palate it shows ripe fruit and lightly nutty flavours balanced by crisp, lemony acidity. Good weight and texture through to the finish.



Montresor Rosé Royal Pinot Noir Spumante NV
VENETO, ITALY

A delicate pale pink colour. Subtle and persistent bubbles. Rich toasty aromas of bread, mingle with flower blossom, ripe apples and cherries. Elegant and balanced palate, finishes with good length.

La Colombaia Amarone della Valpolicella
VENETO, ITALY

Ripe, warm and generous on the nose with abundant plum and cherry aromas, roasted coffee beans and hints of dried fruits. Full bodied and richly flavoured with rich berry and plum fruit, supple tannins and a spicy finish, with the characteristic dry bite of good Amarone. A balanced and very approachable style.



2017 Monte Schiavo Alberto Serenelli Rosso Conero
MARCHE, ITALY
£51.54 *per case of 6 bottles

An intense, ripe and inviting nose of plum, dried fruit, black cherry and spice. The wine is powerful with ripe blackberry and bitter chocolate characters, balanced by earthy notes - savoury and spicy with rich well-structured tannins, smooth and lasting on the finish. A full, satisfying red with concentration, drinkability and the ability to age.



Castel del Lupo Pinot Nero 'Della Quercia' [Organic]
LOMBARDIA, ITALY
£49.19 *per case of 6 bottles

Pronounced, warm, ripe, black-fruited, spicy and complex aromas. Lively acidity offsets the ripe wild plum and bramble fruit and the palate combines concentration, delicacy and structure.





Uggiano Chianti Riserva 'La Scoperta'
TOSCANA, ITALY

Vibrant black fruit aromas with a touch of spice. On the palate layers of ripe plum, blackcurrant and juicy black cherry balance spicy, developed flavours. A well-structured and complex wine with ripe tannins and bright acidity on the finish.

**2016 Scacciavioli
Montefalco Rosso**
UMBRIA, ITALY

£63.54 *per case of 6 bottles

Predominantly Sangiovese with a dash of powerful Sagrantino and plummy Merlot in the blend. This is a juicy, bright and almost floral wine. With tons of red berry fruit and a refreshing finish. Still a fair whack of tannin but nicely harmonised, it's only going to taste better with food.



Chile:

Raspberry Ripple

*37.5ml cuckoo sunshine gin
12.5ml chambord
25ml fresh lemon juice
25ml sugar syrup
3 fresh raspberries
prosecco to top*

1. Pour the gin, chambord, lemon and sugar syrup into a cocktail shaker.
2. Muddle the raspberries into these and then fill the shaker with ice.
3. Shake well and then strain into a chilled wine glass over ice, top with prosecco and then finish with a sprig of mint (we recommend hitting it against the back of your hand to express the mints oils) and a fresh raspberry - summer in a glass!

*all of these cocktails were made using the 20cl bottles of Lunetta prosecco, an absolute steal at £28.50 for a case of 12! One 20cl bottle would easily make two cocktails.





Pornstar Martini

The Pornstar Martini has probably shot up in popularity thanks to the playful name, it supposedly is the most popular cocktail in the UK! Though there are slight variations on the recipe this is the one which we think tastes best!

*37.5ml vanilla vodka
20ml passoa
12.5 fresh lemon juice
12.5 vanilla syrup (could also even use a little drop of vanilla extract in its place)
100ml pineapple juice
prosecco shot served on side
half a passion fruit to garnish*

1. Pour the vanilla vodka, passoa, lemon juice, vanilla syrup and pineapple juice into the shaker and fill with ice.
2. For this cocktail an extra hard shake is required in order to create the lovely velvety foam that is so synonymous with this cocktail. We recommend shaking the drink with all your might for a good 15-20 seconds so as to not be disappointed.
3. Then strain the cocktail into a chilled coupe and if shaken with enough power you should see a thick foamy layer appearing on top of your cocktail.
4. Cut a passion fruit in half and float it on top of the cocktail.
5. Finally serve a shot of prosecco on the side which can either be drunk as a pallet cleanser or poured into the drink to add carbonation and dryness depending on your preference.



Rosé 75

A twist on the classic French 75 cocktail. The French 75 is a cocktail made from gin, Champagne, lemon juice, and sugar. The drink dates to World War I, and an early form was created in 1915 at the New York Bar in Paris, later Harry's New York Bar, by barman Harry MacElhone. The combination was said to have such a kick that it felt like being shelled with the powerful French 75mm field gun. Our variation simply swaps out the champagne for rosé prosecco.

*25ml gin
12.5ml lemon
12.5ml sugar syrup
rosé prosecco to top*

1. Pour the gin, fresh lemon and sugar syrup into a cocktail shaker and fill with ice.
2. Shake well and then strain into a chilled champagne flute (straining through a small sieve will help catch any small shards of ice broken up during the shaking process). Top with rose prosecco and then garnish with a strip of lemon zest if you like, (twisting the lemon strip will aid in bringing out oils, furthermore, running it along the rim of the glass will enhance the lemon flavour and scent of the drink).



Kir Royale

Kir Royale is a French cocktail, a variation on Kir. It consists of crème de cassis topped with champagne, rather than the white wine used in traditional Kir. Crème de cassis is a sweet, dark red liqueur made from blackcurrants.

*25ml crème de cassis
prosecco to top*

1. Pour the crème de cassis into a chilled champagne flute.
2. Usually prosecco would be floated atop the crème de cassis by carefully pouring it down a bar spoon in order to create separation in the drink but it can just as easily be poured straight into the glass if you don't have access to the correct tools.
3. It can be garnished with a fresh blackberry if you'd like, but generally doesn't require a garnish due to the impressive separation in the drink.



Lemon Drop

25ml limoncello
25 ml fresh lemon juice
25ml sugar syrup
prosecco to top

1. Pour the limoncello, fresh lemon and sugar syrup into a cocktail shaker and then fill with ice.
2. Shake well and strain into a chilled champagne flute, (straining through a small sieve will help catch any small shards of ice broken up during shaking). Top with prosecco and then garnish with a strip of lemon zest if you like, (twisting the lemon strip will aid in bringing out oils, rimming the glass then helps enhance the lemon flavour of the drink).



Strawberry Fields Forever

37.5ml larios pink gin
12.5 elderflower liqueur
25 lime
25 sugar syrup
1 large or 2 smaller strawberries
prosecco to top

1. Pour the gin, elderflower liqueur (elderflower cordial could just as easily be used in place of the liqueur) lime and sugar syrup into a cocktail shaker. Cut the strawberry into quarters and then muddle into the liquid. Fill the cocktail shaker with ice.
2. Shake well and then strain into a chilled coupe glass. Finish by topping the drink up with prosecco and garnish with a fresh strawberry or a wheel of fresh lime.
